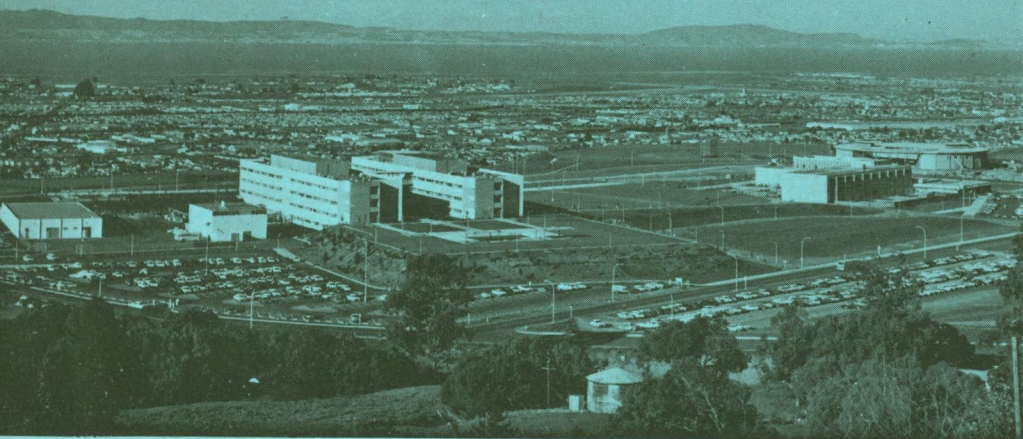

### CALENDAR

March 15-June 16	Application to enroll in Summer Session.
June 16	Application deadline for students attending the Summer Session only. Lengthy delays may be avoided at registration if filed by June 16.
June 21	Registration. Applicants by June 1, will receive preferential time to register in morning. Open registration 1:00-6:00pm.
June 22	Classes begin
June 22	Late registration period.
June 22	Last day to add class.
July 2	Last day to drop classes without record of enrollment.
July 30	End of Session.
August 2	Grades due in Records Office for Summer Session.

### IMPORTANT DEADLINE

All students, especially new students and those who have not been in continuous attendance, are urged to complete the form in the back of this announcement. Priority in line during registration will be granted students who file their application prior to June 1. Students who have not submitted the form by June 16 may experience lengthy delays in connection with registration on June 21. Workshops beginning after June 21 will provide registration during the first class meeting.

### Who May Attend The Summer Session

Students planning to attend the SUMMER SESSION only, need not complete formal application for admission to the college. Adult students and high school seniors who have been accepted for early admission who have satisfied prerequisites for the courses they wish to take are eligible to attend the summer session. Students under disqualification may enroll in the summer session with the recommendation of the Director of Summer Session and the approval of the Dean of Admission.

### Fees of the Summer Session

Students enrolled for courses being offered during the Summer Session, June 21 to July 30, or any short workshops will pay fees based upon \$11.25 per unit of credit. Student fees for all registrants in courses 3 weeks long or longer are \$3.00. Parking fees for the six-week session are \$5.00.

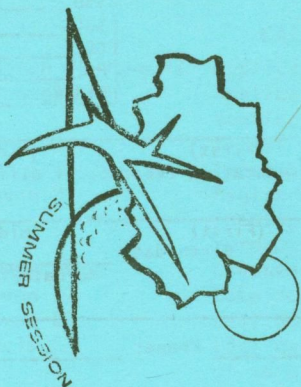
Proposed Schedule--Summer Session, June 21 to July 30
